## **Maternal mortality Rate** is 239 deaths per 100,000 live births (NDHS, 2016)

Social and cultural norms control over women's bodies and sexuality resulting in limited mobility & violence



Health facilities are not Gender sensitive & lacks psycho-social counselling service & women medical practitioner in rural areas 



Lack of access to sexual and reproductive health care services and information contributes to high prevalence of preventable sexual reproductive health problem.

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41% of adolescents aged from 15 to 19 years know abortion is legal in Nepal

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**Reproductive health** right of women with disability is often neglected (NDWA Study, 2016)

22% adolscents girls do not have adequate information on menstruation



The prevalence of Anemia among women aged 15 to 49 has increased to 41% in 2016 from 35% in 2011. (NDHS, 2016)

To provide age specific, rightsbased and evidence based comprehensive sexuality education to boys and girls

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To implement measures to eliminate all forms of gender based violence and discrimination against women and girls
